First Day of School

You will receive information indicating your child's classroom teacher via email. Students will be attending with their regular classroom teacher on the first day of school. Staff will be outside to welcome all students on to the playground and help them find their classroom line ups. **At the bell, students will line up behind the cone with their teacher's name on it.** Teachers will be there to meet the class and escort them in to the building at the start of school, recess and lunch.

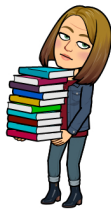
Silver Star Goals this year are for 2025/26

All students will develop social emotional skills to make connections with peers and adults in the school to ensure a safe and caring community and a sense of belonging.

School Supplies:

As always, we ask you all to participate in our school supply program. Your child will receive supplies all year for one **low price**. It is very cost effective for parents. This includes all the supplies required for the school year including art supplies which individual students may not be able to purchase on their own. You can send cash or make cheques payable to Silver Star. Good news! **We do offer an online payment option as well through MyEd.** We encourage all students to take part in our school supply program.

Medications/Medical Alert Plans:

Peanut/Fragrance Allergies:

In addition, please refrain from wearing **strong fragrances** while on school premises as we have staff and students with fragrance allergies.

Symptomatic at School

If students are not well it is expected that they are to **stay at home..**



If your child becomes ill while at school, individuals will be placed in our medical room and a Parent/caregiver will be contacted to pick up an ill student.

Staff who become ill at school may have to leave the school. Know that they will be replaced.
