Staying Home when Sick

During these unprecedented times, we must make sure that parents are doing the Daily Health check. Students who are experiencing any of the symptoms on the list are to remain at home. If a student is experiencing symptoms at school, you will be asked to come and pick up your child and monitor for a full 24 hours. That means if you pick your child up at 11:15 they are to monitored until 11:15 the next day. As students arrive at school, they line up at their class line up indicated by a cone with their teacher's name on it.

Student drop off should not be before 8:15. Teachers start supervision at 8:15. For safety we ask that you hold off on dropping off until supervision starts.

For those students walking to school, we ask that all parents say good bye at the fence to minimize crowding and exposure. Please try to come to school closer to the first bell at 8:25.

We strongly encourage active travel with biking and walking to school.

At end of day there is no supervision, therefore all students are asked to leave the school grounds until the public access begins at 4:30.

We will be having after school workshops for teachers that will take place outside and ask that students not be on school grounds during these sessions.


Late Arrival

Student information should be up to date at the office. Please review the information on MyEd and check to ensure the information is correct if you have not already done so.




Terry Fox Run:
