Medical Alerts for 2024/2025

If you are new to the school you would have received documents to fill out with your physician and return to the school in September. Parents of students with a plan already in place will be contacted at the end of August to update the plan with Administration. This is essential, and it guides our response to medical emergencies for students at school.

- redness, swelling or discharge of the eyes, ears or skin, unless treated.
